I would like to remind you that when you bring your loved ones goodies, please ensure they are store bought and in the original packaging. The packaging should be a material that is able to be disinfected.

For those who would like to bring magazines and books I'd like you to know that this is acceptable. We know how important this is to some of our Elders. We will quarantine these items for 48 hours before delivering.

When you bring items, please ensure they are marked with the name and suite number.

There has already been a couple days of nice weather. This is great! We have been able to have some of your loved ones outside to enjoy the sunshine. We will begin doing a lot more of this as the weather permits.

That's it for updates this week. Please enjoy your weekend and come Monday, remember to continue to be cautious, wear a mask in public and continue social/ physical distancing.
