We also know that we have those special women living at Irene Baron Eden Centre. Here are some restrictions you should be aware of when planning for Mother's Day:

- We are not able to accept flowers
- We will accept cards, books and magazines. These items will be in quarantine for 48 hours before being delivered to your loved one
- Visitation is still restricted which unfortunately includes outdoor visits
- Food will be accepted if it is in a solid, sealed container that we can disinfect. No holes in the container. No plastic storage bags. We will disinfect the container and deliver to the suite.
Please keep in mind that once in the suite we will not be monitoring your containers or be responsible for their return to you. We will not wash or cut fruit so please have it ready to consume.
Perishable items should only be delivered to those who have a fridge in their suite or in small quantities that can be eaten before spoiling.
- Food brought in cardboard boxes or Styrofoam will not be accepted.

We will be celebrating Mother's Day with a Tea Party on each Neighbourhood complete with real china and dainties. We will be observing physical distancing as much as possible.

Both Life Enrichment Team members will be here on Sunday to facilitate many more virtual and window visits.
